GOOD TO KNOW

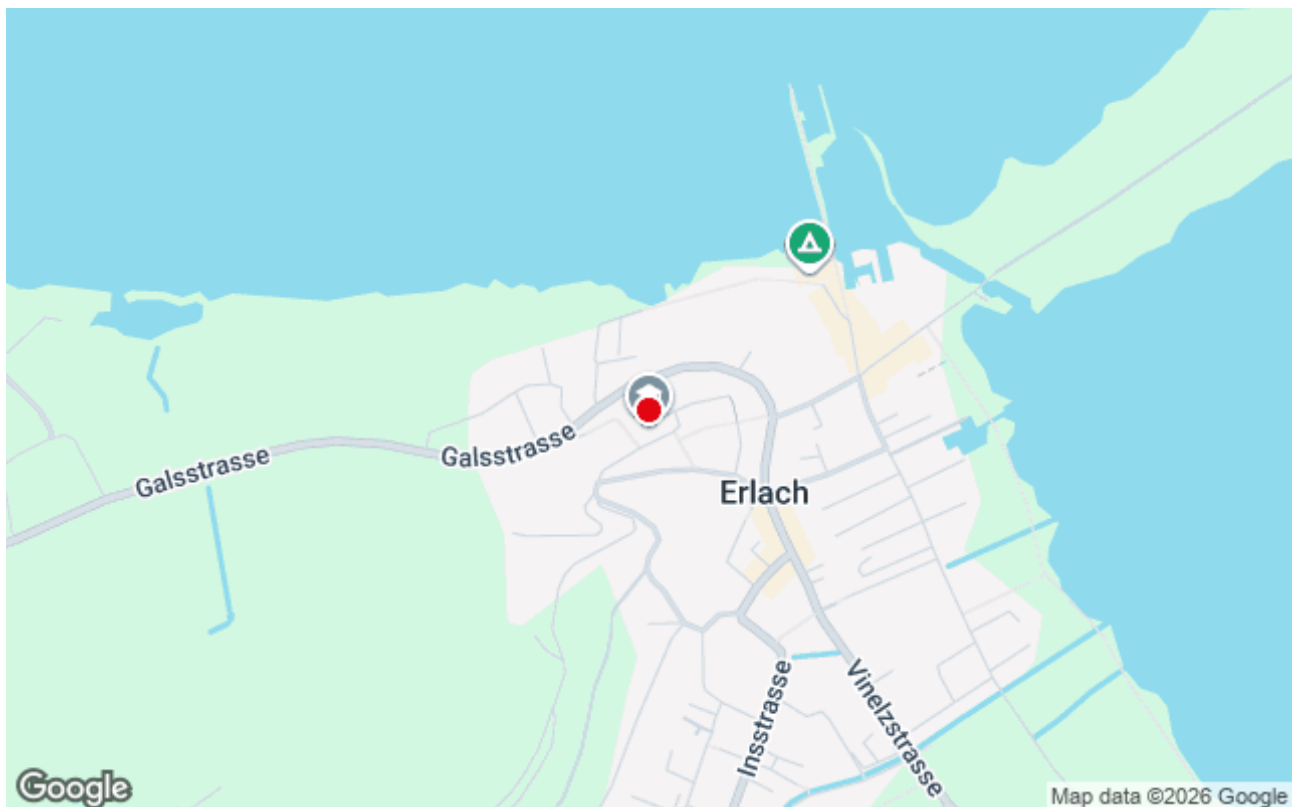
- The small museum inside the castle and the old prison tower can be visited upon request.
