DIDACTIC TRAIL OF THE RISOUD TONEWOOD

Resonance wood is a rare natural resource, highly prized by luthiers. Some of the spruces in the Risoud forest have all the qualities needed to make top-quality musical instruments. This 6.4km educational trail offers hikers the chance to discover all the special features of this exceptional wood through 10 richly illustrated panels.

GOOD TO KNOW

- Accessible on foot most of the year and on cross-country skis when there is snow
- The walk takes place on a tarmac forest road and a stony track.
- The physical panels are in French, but the content is available in German and English on the website.
