Since its complete renovation in 2006, the old power station has been running at full capacity. Powered by the Suze, its turbine generates almost 2 million kWh of sustainable electricity every year.

Nestled in an exceptional natural setting, the Taubenloch hydroelectric power station is a perfect destination for a day out. It offers visitors the chance to learn all about energy production while soaking up the atmosphere and beauty of the gorges -these natural wonders carved out by the force of water.
