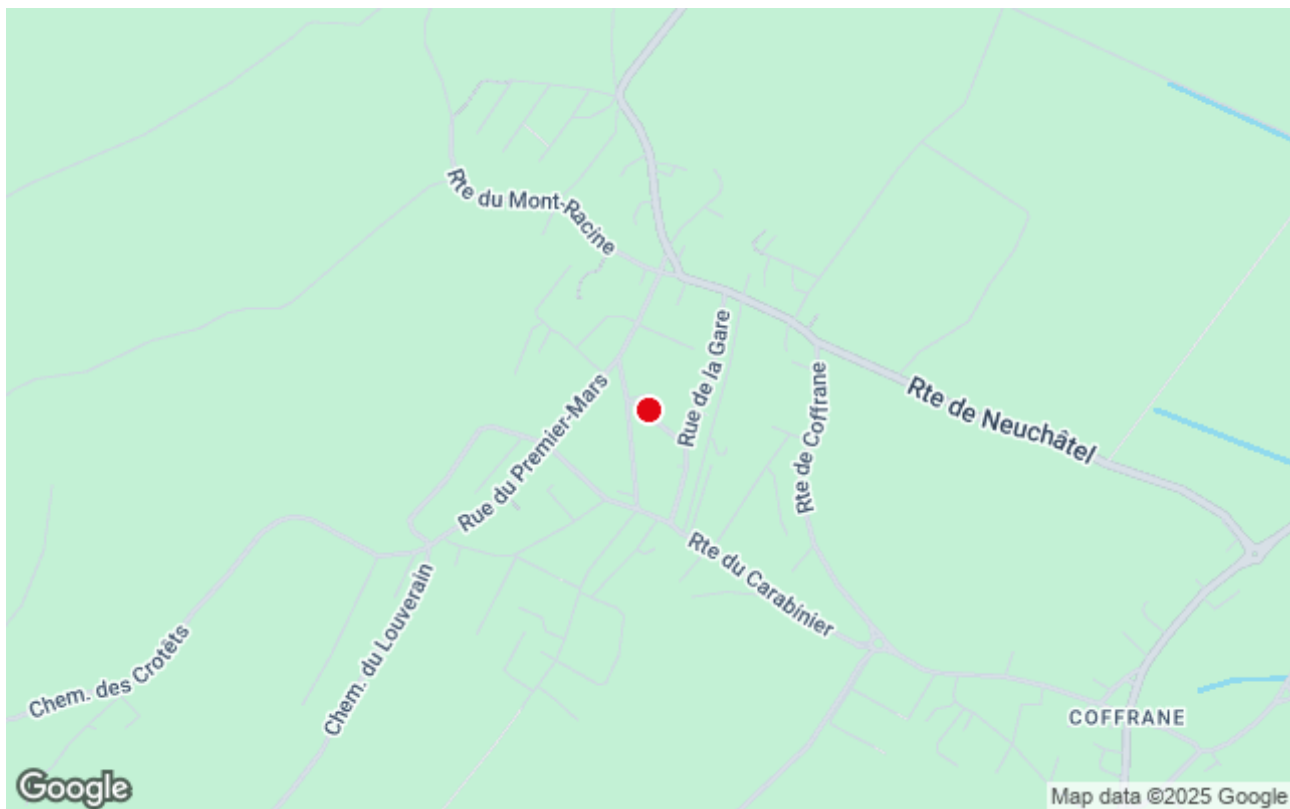

GOOD TO KNOW

- Self-guided tour of the FELCO exhibition
- Free admission without reservation during shop opening hours (8:00 a.m.–12:00 p.m. / 1:30 p.m.–5:00 p.m.)
- Registration required at reception/shop
- Guided tour of the factory (FELCO exhibition included)
- Duration: approx. 2 hours
- As the factory is a real industrial environment, it can be noisy. Children under the age of 8 are admitted free of charge, under the supervision of their parents. However, the technical nature of the tour generally makes it more interesting for children aged 10 and above.
- The value of the ticket becomes a voucher worth CHF 50 or more at the FELCO shop
- Individual times:
 - Tuesday 9:15 a.m.
 - Wednesday 9:15 a.m. or 2:15 p.m.
 - Thursday 2:15 p.m.
- Up to 10 people maximum
- Languages: FR and, with audio guides, DE and EN. Other languages on request
- Online booking required
- Groups of more than 10 people: booking via the dedicated form (reserved days: Tuesday afternoon and Thursday morning)
