WATCHMAKING TOWN PLANNING SHOWROOM

The Watchmaking Urbanism Space offers an immersion into the unique urban heritage of this city, which is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Designed and developed around the watchmaking industry, La Chaux-de-Fonds is a rare example of a city planned to meet the needs of a specific industry.

Through exhibitions and historical documents, the space highlights the close link between urban organisation, architecture and economic development based on watchmaking. Visitors discover how the watchmaking industry shaped the very structure of the city: straight streets, large windows, workshops integrated into homes, etc. This is an unmissable visit for understanding how the watchmaking industry and urban planning influenced each other, creating a model that is unique in the world.


- Access by public transport: bus n° 301, 303, 311 or 312 (stop Théâtre)
