Our guide will introduce you to the Jura's medieval gem and the many anecdotes and legends during a fascinating guided tour.

- The lantern-lit guided tour is only available during the winter saison (october to march).
- Tribunes baroques offers organ concerts at the Collegiate Church of Saint-Ursanne. It is possible to book a musical interlude before or after a guided tour of the town.
