GOOD TO KNOW


- Groups: up to 25 people per guide (up to 15 for the Circuit Secret)

- It is not possible to visit the castle on weekends since it is an administrative building. Nevertheless, the Circuit secret grants access to several unusual places nearby which are usually closed.

- Watchmaking is a prominent industry in Porrentruy and "watchmaking tours" are also available for booking.
