

GROUP ACCOMMODATION, CHAMP-DU-MOULIN

MAISON ROUSSEAU

Maison Rousseau, a former manor house that hosted Jean-Jacques Rousseau in 1764, is located in the heart of the Creux-du-Van Nature Reserve, on the banks of the Areuse River. Accessible year-round by car or train (CFF Champ-du-Moulin station, a 10-minute walk away), it benefits from an outstanding natural setting.

The house offers 37 beds, distributed as follows:

- 4 dormitories with 4 beds each
- 1 dormitory with 7 beds
- 1 dormitory with 14 beds

Situated in the Areuse gorges at the foot of the Creux-du-Van, Maison Rousseau provides a splendid setting. Surrounded by green spaces, it is perfectly suited for relaxation, outdoor activities, games, or the organization of family gatherings over a weekend.

Ground floor

- Fully equipped professional kitchen (40 place settings)
- Dining room
- Activity room
- Office / room for supervisors (4 beds)
- 2 toilets and 1 shower

First floor

- Large, fully wooden hall
- Semi-covered terrace
- Library (with 4 beds)
- Knights' Hall (not available for rent)
- 2 toilets and 2 showers

Second floor

- 2 dormitories with 4 beds each
- 1 dormitory with 14 beds
- 1 dormitory with 7 beds
- 1 toilet
- 1 toilet with shower
