SWISS MUSEUM OF FASHION

The MuMode draws on its extensive collection, dating from the 18th century to the present day, when planning its exhibitions on a variety of themes: film costumes, haute couture, moulding techniques, children's fashion, up-and-coming designers, and intelligent fabrics.

Its archive collections, which can be viewed by prior arrangement, include stored items from the couturier Robert Piguet (Yverdon-les-Bains, 1898–Lausanne, 1953), founder of an haute couture house in Paris (1933-1951). Trained by Paul Poiret and Redfern, he opened his house overlooking the Rond-Point des Champs-Élysées and hired young and promising designers such as Christian Dior, Hubert de Givenchy and Marc Bohan. At its peak, the fashion house employed more than 400 people in the French capital.
