SKI LIFTS LES PRÉS-D'ORVIN

The ski resort of Les Prés-d'Orvin is located in a natural setting on the first southern foothills of the Jura range. The ski area stretches along the north-facing slopes of Mont-Sujet, between 1,030 m and 1,230 m above sea level. Two ski lifts lead to various blue and red runs, while three baby lifts and a snow bob lift are available for beginners. Around 5 kilometers of marked pistes are offered, including a toboggan run. From Tuesday to Friday, the slopes are illuminated from 7:15 p.m. to 9:45 p.m. in good weather. Ski and snowboard equipment can be rented, and lessons can be booked. For food and refreshments, two slope-side snack bars and the Restaurant Le Grillon are available.



GOOD TO KNOW

- Number of ski lifts: 2
- Kilometres of runs: 7 km
- Number of pistes: 6 (blue)
- Minimum altitude: 1035 m
- Maximum altitude: 1300 m
- 3 ski lifts for children
- Ski lifts I and II are free for children up to and including 6 years old
- Transport: from Biel/Bienne station, take bus no. 70 towards Les Prés-d'Orvin (terminating at "Bellevue"). Large car park available.
- Lighting: the pistes are floodlit from Tuesday to Friday, 7.15 p.m. to 21.45 p.m..
- 4 km (2.5-mile) winter trail from the "Bellevue" bus stop to the Farm Restaurant "Bison Ranch".
- Snowpark (according to snow conditions)
- A toboggan run
- 2 snack bars and restaurants available
