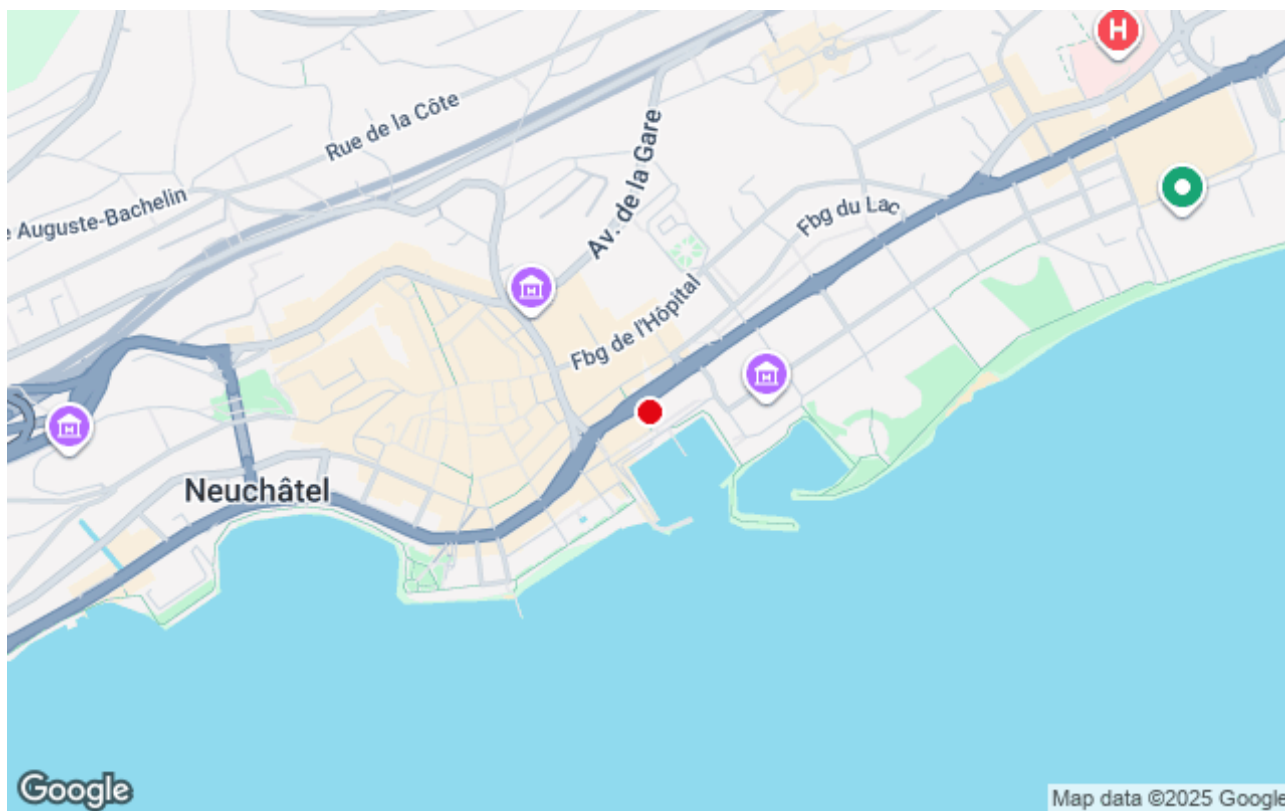
- Departure from the Place du Port: 1.30, 2.30, 3.30 and 4.30 p.m.
