# CELTIC OPPIDUM

Traces of the rampart 600 metres long can still be seen. The oppidum was destroyed by fire by the Celts themselves in - 58 BC, before their migration to Gaul.

For the National exhibition Expo 02, a considerable archaeological dig was carried out and a part of one gateway was reconstructed as would have been the original.

## GOOD TO KNOW

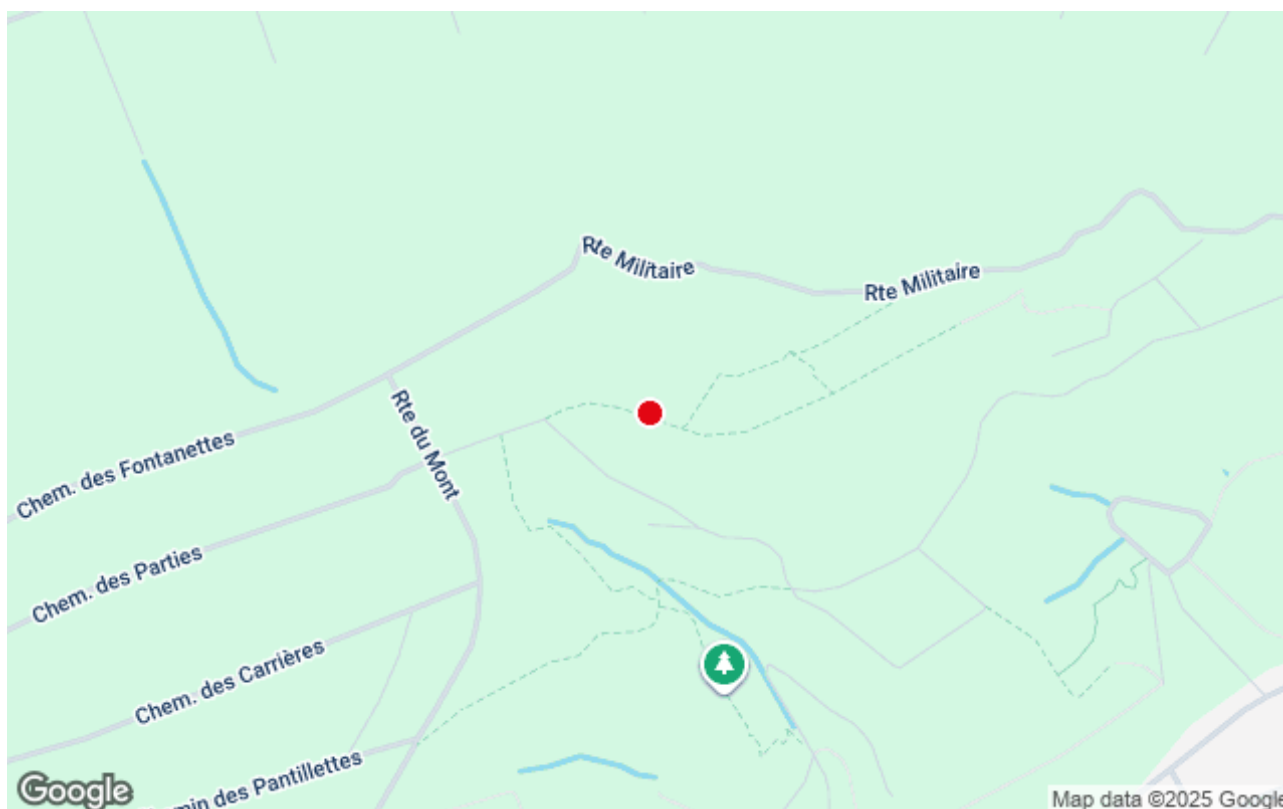
- The oppidum is located on the Historical Path.
