GOOD TO KNOW

- The path is steep and some parts consist of steps carved directly into the rock.
- The Groupe d'Alpinistes des Franches-Montagnes (GAFM) has built a refuge for rock climbers and hikers passing through the region. It is accessible on foot from the village of Muriaux – follow the footpath (yellow markers) towards Noirmont – or from Noirmont, follow the footpath towards Saignelégier. Allow about 45 minutes for the walk.

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
