Piece by piece, the history of the village of Studen has been discovered. Today, the temple ruins and Roman gate are preserved. This hill left its mark on the history of the whole region for more than five centuries: with the presence of a Celtic oppidum and a prosperous Roman town considered as the economic and religious centre for the Seeland and region around Biel/Bienne.

- The Roman gate is in the village of Studen and the temple ruins are only accessible by foot.

- The archaeological discoveries can be seen at the NMB.
